The 3MR0501 offers multistage filtration, incorporating separate sediment and chlorine taste & odor filters for excellent membrane module protection, a sanitary, encapsulated reverse osmosis membrane, a carbon block post-filter for superior flow from a dedicated faucet and a high-pressure booster pump for increased and more consistent production.

The 3M system's 110 VAC booster pump delivers a consistent driving pressure of 100 psi regardless of the regular feed pressure coming into a home, dramatically increasing production levels with the ability to deliver up to 36.78 gallons of cleaner, great-tasting water per day.[†]


